**D) CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL, INVOCATION, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Let the record show that Mayor, Anthony Howard, call the meeting to order. Mayor, Anthony Howard, Councilman Frank Thornton, Councilman Charles Middleton and Councilman Al Hutchins were present. Let the record show that Councilman James Crozier was not present. Also present was the City Clerk.

**II) Law Enforcement Contract**

A motion was made by Councilman Middleton and seconded by Councilman Thornton to approve the Resolution the separate Law Enforcement and create a Blakely Police Dept. The motion carried with Mayor Howard, Councilman Thornton and Councilman Middleton voting "YEH."

**III) Oxford Resurfacing Quote**

Craig Hughes presented the Council with a packet for the resurfacing project. He has broken the project into Phase I and Phase II. He explained the two phases to the Council for a total cost of \$209,950. He then explained that Phase II was to add College and River Streets from the Square to Church St and Chattahoochee to Cedar Springs. He then stated that with the additional streets he was looking at a cost of \$301,197.77. He stated that Oxford recommends milling and there was not a real cost savings to not mill. The Council discussed that there really wasn't an option not to mill. There was then discussion regarding cost and funding, LMIG and borrow from savings accounts and replace as TSPLOST starts coming in. There was also discussion regarding the street markings. The Mayor stated that he wanted to continue submitting streets each year for the LMIG. A motion was made by Councilman Middleton and seconded by Councilman Thornton to approve the Oxford bid with the additional streets and Church St from Cedar Springs to MLK. The motion carried unanimously by Councilman present.

**IV) ADJOURNMENT**

A motion was made by Councilman Middleton and seconded by Councilman Thornton to adjourn the September 17<sup>th</sup> Special Called meeting. The motion carried unanimously by Councilman present.
