



Blakely City Council Minutes

January 11, 2021 Early County Commission, 6:00 P.M.

- I. Call To Order, Roll Call, Invocation, Pledge Of Allegiance
Let the record show that Mayor Travis Wimbush call the City Meeting to Order. Mayor Travis Wimbush, Councilmember Margaret Davis, Councilmember Ray Jarrett and Councilmember Brad Clenney were present. Councilmember Al Hutchins was not present. Also present was the City Clerk Melinda Crook. The City Attorney Tommy Coleman was not present. Mike Newberry gave the invocation. All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- II. LMIG Project
A motion was made by Councilmember Clenney and seconded by Councilmember Jarrett to approve submission for LMIG funds in the amount of \$62,922.07 with a 30% match from the City. These funds are to be used on the streets in the City Cemetery if acceptable and that there is a proposal for \$65,000 or another designated area if so needed. The motion carried unanimously by Councilmembers present
- III. Proposed CDBG with Regional Commission
The Mayor informed the Council that Advocates for Better Communities would no longer be doing grants for the City. A motion was made by Councilmember Clenney and seconded by Councilmember Davis to approve using the Regional Commission for the 2021 CDBG. The motion carried unanimously by Councilmembers present
- IV. Second Reading and Adoption of Consumption on Premises Ordinance
A motion was made by Councilmember Clenney and seconded by Councilmember Davis to adopt the Ordinance for On Premises Consumption. The motion carried unanimously by Councilmembers present
- V. New Items Proposed By Mayor And City Council
The Mayor informed the Council that the GA Forestry is requesting an ice machine that is broke and no longer in use. He stated that GA Forestry feels they can repair the ice machine. A motion was made by Councilmember Jarrett and seconded by Councilmember Clenney to declare the ice machine surplus equipment. The motion carried unanimously by Councilmembers present
A motion was made by Councilmember Jarrett and seconded by Councilmember Clenney to approve donating the surplus ice machine to the GA Forestry Commission. The motion carried unanimously by Councilmembers present

The Mayor asked that it continued to be reiterated about the 6ft distance and mask wearing regarding COVID-19. The Mayor then stated that per capita if the City meets or exceeds those




