Education/Requirements:

- High School Diploma
- US Citizen
- Must be of good moral character
- Must be 18 or older
- No felony convictions
- Must be able to complete all requirements within a 6 month probationary period
- Successful completion of background check/fingerprints/other additional requirements may be needed for clearance in accordance with GCIC background check.
- Must be able to complete and maintain Basic Communications Certification as mandated by the State of Georgia and POST Council.
- Must be able to complete and maintain Emergency Medical Dispatcher Certification
- Must be able to complete and maintain CPR Certification
- Must be able to complete and maintain GCIC/NCIC Certification
- Possess and maintain a valid Georgia Driver's License
- Requires ability to work a rotating 8-12 hour shift, with various off days, holidays, and weekends. Shifts are subject to change on short notice, must be able to work holidays, weekends, and any period beyond 40 hour work week that may be requested.
- Requires the ability to work in a confined space for an extended amount of time.
- Requires ability to take meals and breaks as workload permits, limited set period of time during shift.
- Requires the mental ability to make decisions in critical situations.
