I) Call To Order, Roll Call, Invocation

Let the record show that the Mayor, Anthony Howard, Councilman Al Hutchins, Councilman Charles Middleton, Councilman Frank Thornton, Councilman James Crozier and assistant clerk Trudie Evans were present. Councilman Crozier gave the invocation.

The purpose of this meeting was to hold a work session to review the engineer findings in the evaluation of the water and sewer system in the Redbud Street / Meadowbrook Street areas. Mr. Jeff Jones with Polyengineering discussed his findings with the council. His water study focused on 2 fire hydrants, one on Meadowbrook and one on Redbud. Mr. Jones proposed installation of an 8 inch water main down College Street to increase the flow and PSI at these hydrants. The total cost of that project was given as \$225,610.00. No action was taken at this time. A complete print out of Mr. Jones' power point presentation showing his findings will be included in the minute book with these minutes.

Mr. Danny Day and Mrs. Betty Day addressed the council in opposition to the proposed closing of North Bay Street.

Mr. Greg Grimsley with Birdsong addressed the council explaining the reasons Birdsong requests a section of North Bay Street be closed.

No action of the road closing was taken at this time.
